The Spokane Education Association has set aside a \$1,000.00 scholarship for a graduating high school senior or college student who is a dependent of a Spokane Education Association member. A check will be mailed to the registrar of a Washington State four-year college or community college when the student is officially enrolled. If the recipient has not enrolled within one year of his/her high school graduation, the scholarship shall be awarded to a qualified alternate.

This scholarship is intended to support qualified <u>students entering the teaching profession</u> and therefore will be awarded to an applicant intending to pursue a career in education.
