STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

The Spokane Education Association has designated a \$1,000.00 scholarship for a graduating high school senior or college student who is a dependent of a Spokane Education Association member. The applicant does not have to be graduating from Spokane Public Schools but should plan on enrolling or be currently enrolled at a Washington State institution in the field of education.

Consideration shall be given to scholastic ability, financial need, college aptitude, participation in activities involving children, personal traits which are indicators of success in the teaching profession.

An SEA committee will review completed applications and select the winner. A check will be mailed to the registrar of a Washington State four-year college or community college when the student is officially enrolled. If the recipient has not enrolled within one year of his/her high school graduation, the scholarship shall be awarded to a qualified alternate.

This scholarship is intended to support qualified students entering the teaching profession and therefore will be awarded to an applicant intending to pursue a career in education.

A complete application shall include the following:

- Student's application form
- Student's personal statement - Form A
- Teaching staff recommendation - Form B
- Character reference other than faculty member - Form C
- Transcript of grades (official or unofficial)
