



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE SPOKANE SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE SPOKANE EDUCATION ASSOCIATION REPRESENTING CERTIFICATED TEACHERS- HIGH SCHOOL RESOURCE TEACHERS

## CASELOAD REDUCTION

The Association and the District agree to enter an MOU for the 2022-23 school year that converts the current contract language Paraeducator allocation (6.5 Hours per one resource room teacher) to Certificated Resource Room FTE. Each high school will be able to convert their paraeducator allocation to certificated teacher FTE using their existing CBA Waiver from the 2021-2022 School Year. Should a building choose to convert more Paraeducator time to Certificated FTE than they did in the 2021-22 school year, both the District and Association will need to review and accept the change.

The Association and District agree to the terms of this Agreement for the duration of the school year. Any new language bargained will go into effect during the 2023-2024 school year.
